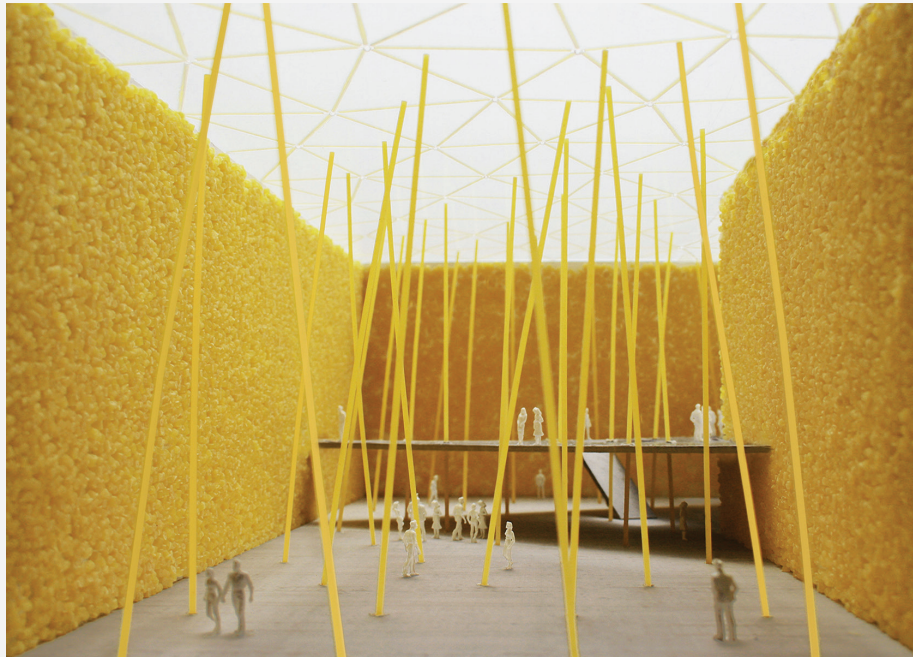


# BARILLA PAVILLION - TORINO, ITALY

In typological terms, the new pavillion is a GALLERIA. Deriving from the Greek Stoa, the "Galleria degli Antichi" built in 1585 in Sabbioneta is the most direct reference, only 25km. far away.

In terms of space, it is a skylight gallery, such as the ones in Milan, Turin, Naples etc.

The new building is 450m. long x 25m. wide x 16,5m. high. The tower is 49,5m. high.

It is a long route in which all the different activities are placed one following the other, from the hall to the panoramic restaurant.

From the top, all visitors will enjoy the view of Barilla Pedrignano Campus, the A1 "autostrada del sole", the countryside.
