The new system is formed by the articulation of orthogonal volumes separated from each other: this will allow a possible construction in stages.

The new buildings take the structural step suggested by the existing kindergarten building, as a real replicable genetic character, as well as the depth of the building.

The new system can thus be read on the one hand as an extension of the old, on the other as an expansion of open spaces.

The extension of the nursery school, facing it, seems the most suitable to confirm the structural rhythm and east-west orientation of the classrooms.

The gym instead, designed as a basement volume, undergoes a 90-degree rotation separating the large outdoor fields: the hard one located south of the compartment and the grassy one to the north.
